1/10/19 – Lovell Coleman / Robert Llewellyn Catch up with a local builder and musician who has been playing fiddle in the Charlottesville area and beyond for nine decades; then sit down with a well-respected nature photographer and philosopher who hopes to inspire others to not just look, but to see.

1/17/19 – Eddie Harris / UVA Clinical Skills Center Standardized Patient Program Meet a mentor in our community whose mission is to help fathers—some who are incarcerated—to be better parents and partners; then learn about a program that recruits and trains members of the community to serve as simulated patients for med students at the University of Virginia.

1/24/19 – Henry Browne / Eric Hurt Explore Virginia ruins and vanishing history with an area author; then talk with a local filmmaker who works around the world, but enjoys building community and creating films locally.

1/31/19 – The Prism Coffeehouse Series / Wildrock Hear about an acoustic music series with roots in Charlottesville dating back to the mid-60's; then visit a natural setting designed to provide opportunities for creative play, family bonding, and quiet reflection for people of all ages.

2/7/19 – The Rivanna Conservation Alliance / International Neighbors Learn about an organization that protects the Rivanna River and its tributaries through conservation, education and volunteer involvement; then hear from a group that provides support services to area refugees and special immigrant visa holders to help them along their path to self-sufficiency and productive citizenship.

2/21/19 – New Dominion Bookshop / Panorama Farms Stop by a popular independent book store that has been serving our community since 1924; then visit a local farm to find out how one family is cultivating innovative ways to maintain the property's rural character and remain sustainable through changing times.

2/28/19 – Dr. A.D. Carson / The Wildlife Conservation Center Meet a performance artist and professor who teaches philosophy, sociology, history, and music through his Hip Hop class at the University of Virginia; then learn about a local organization dedicated to preserving threatened and endangered wildlife species from around the world.

3/21/19 – Charlottesville Mural Project / Charlottesville High School Veterans History Project Check out an organization that showcases the talents of local, regional and national artists, while adding to the cultural and visual vibrancy of the city; then hear about a veterans' oral history project started by an area educator for his students.

3/28/19 – Albemarle Pipes & Drums / James Madison's Montpelier Hear from a local band that specializes in the traditional music of the Great Highland Bagpipes and Drums; then travel to Orange County to catch up with the executive director of James Madison's Montpelier.

4/11/19 – Heritage Theatre Festival / Loving Cup Vineyard and Winery Check out a professional summer theatre festival that brings national artists and community members together to work on productions with UVA faculty, staff, and students; then visit with the owner of one of the few certified organic wineries on the East Coast.

4/18/19 – Charlottesville Chamber Music Festival / Jefferson Area CHIP Catch up with the co-founders and directors of a world-class chamber music festival; then learn about an organization that partners with families to build a nurturing home environment and promote the health and well-being of children in our community.

4/25/19 – The Martin Luther King Choir / Benjamin Hair Just Swim for Life Foundation Hear from a choir that joins together in music to unify community members of all religions, ethnicities and backgrounds; then learn about an organization that memorializes a local athlete by providing important and fun lifesaving swim lessons to area youth.
