DOC MARTIN AND THE LEGEND OF CLOUTIE (Saturday, January 6 at 8:00 pm)
The Doc (Martin Clunes) goes to great lengths to spook a London family into leaving Tregrunnt Farm, a property he loves. He resorts to an old Cornish witch's trick - a cloutie - a small ribbon of cloth which, if attached to a tree and wished upon, will make wishes come true.

Martin Clunes is on a quest to explore the islands of Australia in this three-part series that provides a fascinating insight into the diversity, history and challenges of island life in Australia.

(Sunday Evenings at 9:00 pm, beginning January 14)

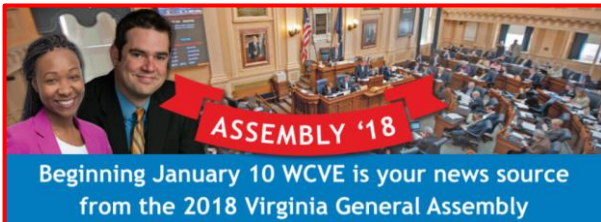
