MAN IN AN ORANGE SHIRT ON MASTERPIECE (*Sunday, June 17 at 9:00 pm*) Two love stories, 60 years apart, chart the changes and challenges in gay lives in England, from the era of jail terms to the onset of dating apps. Vanessa Redgrave stars in this drama scripted by best-selling novelist Patrick Gale.



ENDEAVOUR SEASON 5 ON MASTERPIECE (*Sundays at 9:00 pm, beginning June 24*) Shaun Evans returns for a fifth season of the series as the young Endeavour Morse. Roger Allam also returns as Endeavour's mentor, Detective Inspector Fred Thursday, for more crime-solving in 1960s Oxford.



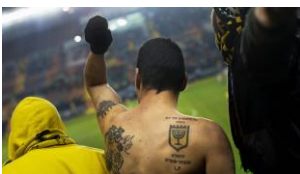

INDEPENDENT LENS: LIMITED PARTNERSHIP (*Tuesday, June 5 at 11:00 pm*) Decades before The Defense of Marriage Act and Proposition 8, one gay couple fell in love and took on the U.S. government to fight for marriage and immigration equality. *Limited Partnership* chronicles the 40-year love story between Filipino American Richard Adams and his Australian husband, Tony Sullivan, who in 1975 became one of the world's first same-sex couples to be legally married.



FOREVEREVERYONE.NET (*Friday, June 8 at 8:30 pm*) Computer programmer Tim Berners-Lee changed the world when he invented the World Wide Web in 1989. His visionary decision to make it a free and accessible resource sparked a global revolution in how we communicate and participate in public life.



INDEPENDENT LENS: FOREVER PURE (*Monday, June 11 at 10:00 pm*) See what happened when two Muslim players joined Israel's most popular and controversial football team. Through the story of one tumultuous season in the life of this famed club, the film offers a dramatic window into modern Israeli society.



POV: QUEST (*Monday, June 18 at 10:00 pm*) Watch an intimate film capturing eight years in the life of a black family from Philadelphia. Follow Christopher "Quest" Rainey, and his wife, Christine's "Ma Quest," as they raise a family and nurture a community of hip-hop artists.



POV: SINGING WITH ANGRY BIRD (*Monday, June 25 at 10:00 pm*) Jae-Chang Kim runs a children's choir in Pune, India. Although his quick temper earned him the nickname "Angry Bird," he has made significant changes in the lives of the choir children. But skeptical of the practical value of music education, their parents are reluctant to let them sing. In order to convince them, Angry Bird decides to train the parents with their children for a joint concert, showing them the power of music in bringing families closer together.
